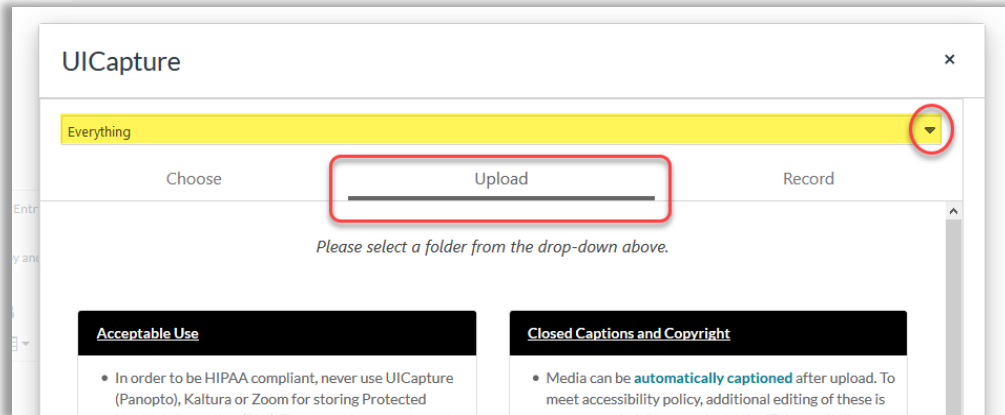
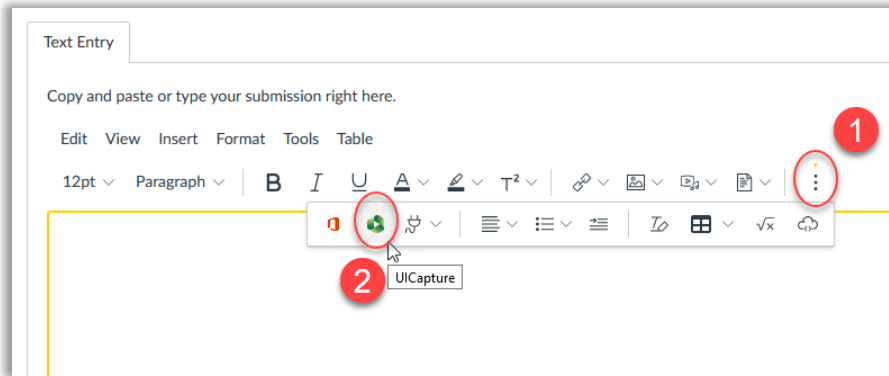

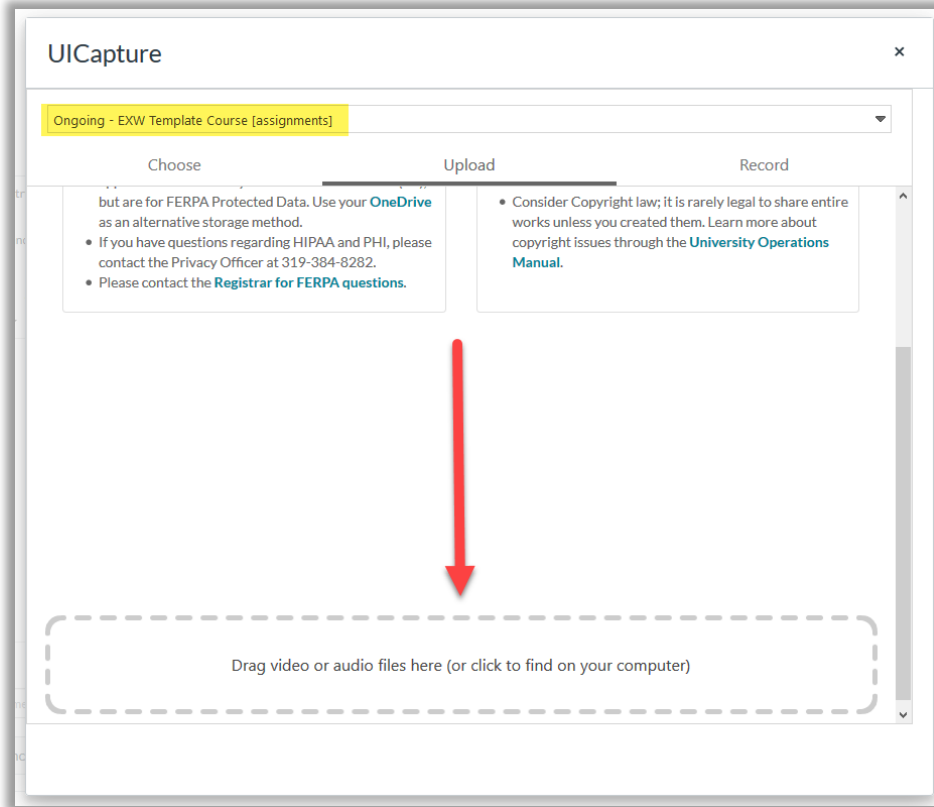
Access UICapture from ICON



- When you are ready to submit your video created with a tool of your choice, go to the assignment and click “Start Assignment” (or “Reply” if posting to a discussion.)
- On the Rich Text Editor screen, click on the “options” (3-dot) icon, then select “UICapture.”
- On the UICapture pop-up window, select the “Upload” tab, then select the target folder in the dropdown list.



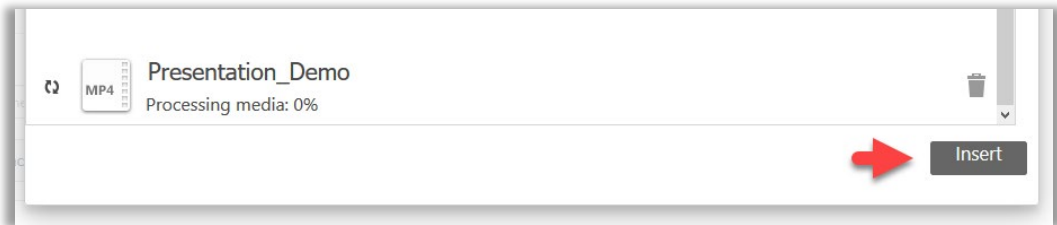
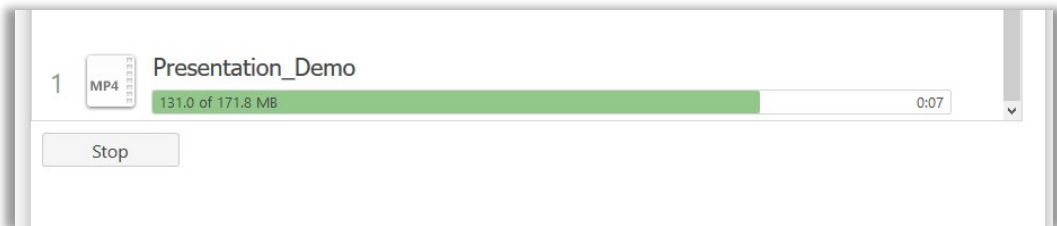
Select Video File



- You can upload the video to “My Folder” location. For some courses students will use a folder with [assignment] at the end. You can search for your folder by typing in the search box.
- Once you have selected the appropriate folder, scroll to the bottom to add your video file.



Upload and Insert



- Upload may take a few minutes and total time varies depending on the file size and your Internet upload speed. If possible, use a wired Internet connection for faster and more stable upload.
- Once upload is finished, click “Insert” to add the video to the assignment.
